Friday, April 17, 2009 – Depart from the U.S.A. for South Africa

Arrive in Johannesburg, go through customs, and fly on domestic flight to Cape Town.

You spend this day in the Arid Klein Karoo where we introduce you to the Ostrich Industry via a guided tour on the Highgate Ostrich Farm. We visit the Cango Wildlife Ranch for a tour of the facility including the Big Cats, Crocodiles and many more. Here you have the opportunity to get up close to a croc by doing a Crocodile Cage Dive as an optional extra. Also you have a similar option of touching a cheetah or Bengal Tiger. This day also includes a wine tasting and tasting of Buchu Brandy. Buchu is a wild medicinal herb used for centuries in both the Boer and black cultures and is indigenous to South Africa.
